# NUI AWARDS 2020

## NUI Grant Scheme for Early Career Academics (Pilot Phase II)

The National University of Ireland is pleased to invite applications for the NUI Grant Scheme for Early Career Academics (offered for a second year) on a pilot basis for competition in the academic year 2019-2020.

Applications for both streams are welcomed from all disciplines, and interdisciplinary and multi-disciplinary proposals are particularly encouraged.

<b>Stream 1: Academic Networking</b>	<b>Stream 2: Conference/Symposium Organisation</b>
Applications are invited for grants of up to €2,000 to support the development of academic connections, networks and collaborations with individuals and named institutions inside and outside of Ireland. Applications must demonstrate at least one proposed collaboration outside of Ireland.	Applications are invited for grants of between €2,000 - €5,000 to lead the organisation and management of an international conference/symposium in the NUI building on Merrion Square (use of NUI facilities included) or in a constituent university (or linked college) or recognised college of NUI.

### Eligibility

Applicants must be holders of one of the following:

- (i) PhD awarded in an NUI constituent university (UCD, UCC, NUI Galway, Maynooth University) or other NUI member institution no earlier than 7 years previously (January 2013);
- (ii) PhD awarded by another HEI no earlier than 5 years previously (2014), and any other NUI degree (e.g. Bachelor, Master);
- (iii) Post-Doctoral Fellowship awarded by NUI or in an NUI constituent university or other NUI member institution and with a start date of no earlier than 3 years previously (January 2016);
- (iv) Current post-doctoral research position at an NUI member institution.

Full-time, permanent members of staff of NUI constituent universities, other NUI member institutions, or other higher education institutions are not eligible to apply.

Only one application will be accepted per applicant in any one year.
