1. Who can apply for the NUI Dr Mary L Thornton Scholarship and Prize in Education 2021?

Candidates who have been accepted, or have applied for admission, to a research degree at doctoral level in the field of Education in a constituent university or recognised college or college linked with a constituent university of NUI are eligible to apply for this Scholarship and Prize.

These eligible institutions include:

- NUI constituent universities, i.e. UCD, UCC, NUI Galway, Maynooth University.
- NUI recognised colleges, i.e. RCSI University of Medicine and Health Sciences, Institute of Public Administration (IPA).
- Other NUI member institutions, i.e. Burren College of Art; NCAD; St. Angela's College, Sligo; Shannon College of Hotel Management; Institute of Banking; Irish Management Institute (IMI).

2. I am an international student. Can I apply for the Dr Mary L Thornton Scholarship and Prize in Education?

International students who meet the eligibility criteria outlined in point 1 above are eligible to apply.

3. Can I apply again for the Dr Mary L Thornton Scholarship and Prize in Education if I applied on a previous occasion?

Yes. Please note however that applications will be accepted from interested candidates on no more than two occasions.

4. Can I apply again for the Dr Mary L Thornton Scholarship and Prize in Education and for the NUI Travelling Doctoral Studentships in the same year?

Yes. Please note however that applications will be accepted from interested candidates on no more than two occasions in each competition.
